Off Licence (For Remote Sites)

Sections 17 to 20, 40 (remote sales) and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (section 40 applies). **Hamilton Liquor Merchants Limited** is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises situated at 13 Simsey Place Te Rapa Park Hamilton 3200, Hamilton and known as **“Gilmours Hamilton”**. And to deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with the Act.

CONDITIONS:

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) **Alcohol may be sold at any time, on any day.**
- (b) Alcohol must not be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day, or between 11:00pm and 6:00am the following day.
- (c) The licensed premise is described in the plan date stamped as received by the Hamilton District Licensing Committee on 3 October 2024.
- (d) A properly appointed certificated, acting, or temporary manager must be on duty and on the premises 07Wholesale Ltd or its successor at all times when the premises is open for the sale of alcohol.
- (e) A Manager’s Register (as required by s 232 of the Act) is to be maintained.
- (f) The licensee must ensure the following are displayed:
 - A copy of the original licence with all the conditions, just inside the principal entrance of 07Wholesale Ltd or its successor so persons entering can read it, and also on the internet site in a prominent place.
 - A sign in a prominent place identifying the duty manager overseeing the delivery of alcohol within the premises of 07Wholesale Ltd or its successor.
- (g) The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer (and if applicable, the receiver) is not under the purchase age.
- (h) For remote sales from the internet site, the licensee must ensure that the sale will not be made unless the buyer (and if applicable, the receiver) completes a declaration that they are 18 years of age or over on first entering the internet site and again immediately before the sale is completed.
- (i) For courier deliveries, the outside of the delivery package must contain the following words:


COURIER WARNING

 - a) Do not leave at destination without proof of delivery.
 - b) Do not leave with persons under 18 years of age. If the receiver appears to be under the age of 25 years check valid identification such as current passport, driver licence or Hospitality NZ 18+ Card Evidence of Age Document to ensure the receiver is 18 years of age or over.
 - c) Do not leave with intoxicated persons.
 - d) Contains alcoholic product.
- (j) Every receipt for the sale of alcohol by remote sale must contain the licence holder’s name, licence number and the date on which the licence expires.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence expires on:

8th day of December 2027

OR, until the close of the period in which this licence is subsequently renewed.
